- The book includes the required 5 single-sided pages of documentation. (5 points)
Only the first 5 pages will be evaluated.
Deduct 1 point for each page missing, do not deduct here for extra pages.
- The book includes at least 1 page of pictures of the project. (2 points)
- Photos include captions that support or extend the project description. (2 points)
- The documentation supports the project? (8 points)
